BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE PERRY COUNTY COMMISSION MET in its regular session on Tuesday, November 9, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. at the Albert Turner, Sr. Courthouse Annex in the commission courtroom. Invocation was led by Albert Turner. Roll call was called to establish a quorum. District #1: Present; District #2: Present; District #3: Present; District #4 Present; District #5: Present.

Motion by Anthony Long and seconded by Thomas Harrison to adopt the agenda. **Motion carried.**

Motion by Benjamin Eaton and seconded by Thomas Harrison to adopt the minutes with the addition that a motion was attempted by Benjamin Eaton for the county to provide free labor and equipment to the City of Uniontown; motion was not recognized by the Chairman. **Motion carried.**
